SUBJECT: 2015 Professional Ethics and Conduct Webcast

On November 19, 2015 from 1:30 p.m. to 3:10 p.m., the North Carolina Association of CPAs (NCACPA) will offer an ethics course by webcast exclusively for State government employees. This course, *2015 Professional Ethics and Conduct*, will satisfy the State CPA Board's annual two-hour Ethics CPE requirement [NCAC 08G.0410 *Professional Ethics and Conduct CPE*]. To register for this webcast:

- Attendees **must pre-register** by clicking on the "Training" link at the top of the OSC web page (<http://www.osc.nc.gov>). The pre-registration deadline is October 19, 2015. (Payment **should not** be made at this time).
- On October 21st, all pre-registered attendees will receive notification by email (from NCACPA) to register for this webcast. NCACPA will provide registration instructions and payment options in their email. NCACPA accepts payment by credit card (MasterCard, Visa, and American Express) and by check (payable to NCACPA). The registration fee is **\$50 per attendee**. Only those individuals who complete the NCACPA registration and payment process will be permitted to participate in this activity. The final registration and payment deadline to NCACPA is November 13th.

Cal Christian, PhD, CPA, will be the course instructor. He is an Associate Professor of Accounting at East Carolina University teaching both Intermediate Accounting and Principles of Accounting. He is a registered CPA in the states of North Carolina and Mississippi, and has over 10 years of experience in both the public accounting profession and in industry. He also teaches continuing education classes for the NCACPA, AICPA, CPA firms, and publicly traded companies—and has been recognized as an NCACPA Outstanding Chapter Speaker, NCACPA Outstanding Conference Speaker, and an NCACPA Outstanding Discussion Leader.
