SUBJECT: 2013 Professional Ethics and Conduct Webcast

On November 19, 2013 from 1:30 p.m. to 3:10 p.m., the North Carolina Association of CPAs (NCACPA) will offer an ethics course by webcast exclusively for State government employees. This course, *2013 Professional Ethics and Conduct*, will satisfy the State CPA Board's annual two-hour Ethics CPE requirement [NCAC 08G.0410 *Professional Ethics and Conduct CPE*]. To register for this webcast:

- Attendees **must pre-register** by clicking on the "Training" link at the top of the OSC web page (<http://www.osc.nc.gov>). The pre-registration deadline is October 3, 2013 (Payment **should not** be made at this time).
- On October 10, all pre-registered attendees will receive notification by email (from NCACPA) to register for this webcast. NCACPA will provide registration instructions and payment options in their email. NCACPA accepts payment by credit card (MasterCard, Visa, and American Express) and by check (payable to NCACPA). The registration fee is **\$50 per attendee** (payable to NCACPA). Only those individuals who complete the NCACPA registration and payment process will be permitted to participate in this activity.

Cal Christian, an Associate Professor of Accounting at East Carolina University, will be the course instructor. Mr. Christian is a registered CPA in the states of North Carolina and Mississippi and has over 10 years of experience in both the public accounting profession and in industry. Mr. Christian has his PhD from Florida State University and his BA from the University of Mississippi. In addition to teaching continuing education courses for the NCACPA, he also teaches and writes courses for the AICPA, CPA firms, and publicly traded companies and has been recognized as a NCACPA Outstanding Chapter Speaker, NCACPA Outstanding Conference Speaker and a NCACPA Outstanding Discussion Leader.

Additionally, OSC will hold the annual Financial Conference for chief fiscal officers and agency designated representatives on December 12, 2013. OSC will also offer a Governmental Accounting and Auditing Update class on June 3, 2014. Additional information about these training classes will be forthcoming.
